**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

This is an application for grant of Succession Certificate under Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicants.

02] It is contended that, applicant no. 1 is wife, applicant No. 2 is son and applicant Nos. 3 and 4 are daughters of deceased *Bajrang Narayan Kale*, who died on 01/10/2025 at Kurduwadi, Tq.Madha, Dist.Solapur. His father and mother are died. After death of *Bajrang Narayan Kale*, applicant Nos. 1 to 4 are being wife, son and daughters are her legal heirs. Deceased Bajrang Narayan Kale and his wife applicant no.1- Jayashri Kale have joint saving account no. 071810100002954 of Bank of India having Rs.12,894.41/- in it. So also, deceased Bajrang Narayan Kale have made Fixed Deposit of Rs. 1,00,895/- vide F.D.Account No. 071845100000181 and Rs. 2,21,900/- vide F.D. Account No. 071845100000590 in Bank of India, Branch-Kurduwadi. After death of Bajrang Narayan Kale, applicant nos. 1 to 4 are the only legal heirs and successors of deceased Bajrang Narayan Kale. Therefore, they are entitled for the succession certificate from the court to get the amount of the deceased which is lying in the above said office. Therefore, the applicants have filed this application for getting succession certificate in their name.

03] Upon application, proclamation (Exh. No. 5) was issued in the form contained in Appendix 'A' inviting all persons for calling objections.

04] Public notice (Exh. No.11) was issued in daily news paper 'Dainik Punya Nagari' on 04/02/2026 for calling objections from public at large. Nobody appeared in the Court disputing claim and relation of the applicant with deceased as asserted in the application, proclamation and public notice.

05] In order to prove the claim, applicant no. 3 has filed her evidence by way of affidavit (Exh.No.9), verified copy of adhar cards of applicant nos. 1 to 4 (Exh.16 to 19), paper notice (Exh.11), verified copy of death certificate of Bajrang Narayan Kale (Exh.No.12), verified copy of receipt of Bank of India F.D. Account No. 071845100000181 (Exh. 13), verified copy of receipt of Bank of India F.D. Account No. 071845100000590 (Exh. 14), verified copy of Bank of India pass-book Saving Account No. 071810100002954 of deceased Bajrang Narayan Kale and Jayashri Kale (Exh. No. 15) and closed evidence vide pursis (Exh. No. 10). Their evidence has remained unchallenged.

06] It is evident from death certificate (Exh. 12) of Bajrang Narayan Kale that he died on 01/10/2025 at Kurduwadi, Tq.Madha, Dist.Solapur. Thus, applicant nos. 1 to 4 are being wife, son and daughters are her only legal heirs. Moreover, nobody has disputed their status. Hence, they are entitled to get Succession Certificate. Thus, considering these facts, application deserves to be allowed in the interest of justice. Hence, for these reasons, following order is passed.

**:: ORDER ::**

1]	The application allowed.
2]	Succession certificate be issued in favour of applicant nos. 1 to 4 to collect an amount of <b>Rs.12,894.41/-</b> lying in joint <b>saving account no. 071810100002954</b> of <b>Bank of India</b> of <b>Bajrang Narayan Kale and Jayashri Bajrang Kale</b> , <b>Rs.1,00,895/-</b> of <b>Fixed Deposit Account No. 071845100000181</b> and <b>Rs. 2,21,900/-</b> of <b>Fixed Deposit Account No. 071845100000590</b> in <b>Bank of India, Branch-Kurduwadi</b> lying in the name of the <b>deceased Bajrang Narayan Kale</b> on payment of requisite court fees.
