Perused the application and say. Heard the both sides. On perusal of the record it show that the defendant was served on 17/02/2020 but did not appear in the matter till 04/03/2021. Even, the ex-parte order is passed against him. Thus, considering the fact that from the March 2020 to September 2021 there is Covid-19 the application needs to be allowed in the interest of justice. However, to check delay some costs needs to be imposed. Hence, the application is allowed on the costs of Rs.300/-.

2. The order to proceed the suit ex-parte is hereby set aside.
3. Payment of costs is condition precedent.
4. After making the payment of costs, W.S. be exhibited.
