

Order Passed Below Exh. 01

It appears from record that, the accused is residing beyond the jurisdiction of this Court. Therefore, as per directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo-moto Writ Petition No.02/2020 and as per circular of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court bearing no. Rule-P.1605/2022, the matter was kept for inquiry under Section 202 of the Cr.P.C (Now, as per Section 225 of the BNSS, 2023) vide order below Exh. 01. In view of said order, complainant filed pursis contending that, he placed his reliance on document along with the complaint and does not want to lead further evidence.

2. On perusal of said circular it appears that, in the said circular itself, the Hon'ble High Court empowers magistrate to restrict the said inquiry in suitable cases to examination of documents without insisting for examination of witnesses for satisfaction as to the sufficiency of ground for proceeding of said provisions. The present case appears from the complaint and documents to be fit case to restrict said inquiry and thereby, inquiry under Section 225 of the BNSS, 2023 is hereby restricted to the extent of documents.

3. Further, on perusal complaint, verification and documents i.e. impugned cheque, bank memo, demand notice and acknowledgment/track record, prima-facie, it appears that, accused has committed offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. The present complaint is in limitation. Hence, issue process against the accused accordingly for the offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
