**ORDER BELOW EXH. 01**

This is the application for issuance of Succession Certificate under Section 372 of Indian Succession Act 1925.

2. Perused the application. Heard Ld. advocate for applicants.

3. It is the contention of applicants that, mother of applicant No.1 to 3, mother-in-law of applicant No.3(a) and grand-mother of applicant No.3(b) to 3(d) Prabhavati Tanaji Deshmukh died on 13/06/2021 at Tembhurni, Tal. Madha, Dist. Solapur due to illness. Deceased Prabhavati was residing with applicant No.2. The husband of deceased Prabhavati i.e. Tanaji Deshmukh was in service. After the death of Tanaji, deceased Prabhavati was getting pension being a legal wife. The applicants are only legal heir of deceased Prabhavati. After the death of Prabhavati, on 25/08/2023 being legal heirs of deceased Prabhavati, applicants approached Panchayat Samiti, Kurduwadi for getting arrears of amount of Rs.28,622/- as per 7<sup>th</sup> pay Commission. But, the Block Development Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Kurduwadi demanded Succession Certificate. Hence, present application.

4. Citation and Public Notice was issued as per order of this Court. The applicants produced on record citation at Exh.5 and news paper 'Dainik Katusatya' dated 12/11/2023 at Exh.6. The applicant No.2 filed his evidence affidavit at Exh.10. The applicants have filed the letter of Block Development Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Kurduwadi, Death Certificate of Prabhavati Tanaji Deshmukh, Anil Tanaji Deshmukh and Tanajirao

Narsinhrao Deshmukh, xerox copies of Aadhar Cards of applicants and xerox copy of sanction order to issue GPF amount of deceased Tanajirao Deshmukh to deceased Prabhavati.

5. After publishing public notice in the news paper, nobody appeared and taken any objection during prescribed period for issuance of Succession Certificate in the name of applicants. After going through record, it appears that except the applicants no other legal heirs are there for claiming Succession Certificate of deceased. Hence, there is no hurdle to issue Succession Certificate in the name of applicants.

6. Considering the aforesaid aspects and the relations of applicants with deceased given in application, I am of view that, applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Prabhavati Tanaji Deshmukh. Hence, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

1.	The application is partly allowed.
2.	Issue Succession Certificate in the name of applicants as they are legal heirs of deceased Prabhavati Tanaji Deshmukh in respect of arrears of amount of Rs.28,622/- as per 7 <sup>th</sup> pay Commission.
3.	The applicants to pay necessary Court Fees as per rule.
