

ORDER BELOW EXH. 29 IN R.C.S. No. 170/2025

The present application has been filed by plaintiff seeking permission for production of document. Say of the plaintiff was called.

[2] It is contended by plaintiff that, due to old age, he has given power of attorney to his son namely Aba Sidram Zende for court proceedings. Now, he is filing the copy of said power of attorney. Hence, he seek permission to produce the same on record.

[3] The defendants have filed their say and submitted that, at the time of filing of suit, the plaintiff remained present in the court, thereafter due to illness he intentionally made power of attorney. But the plaintiff has not filed any evidence about his illness. Hence, they prayed to reject the application.

[4] Heard both learned advocates for their parties. Perused the application, say and documents filed on record.

[5] By the present application, plaintiff is seeking permission to produce the copy of power of attorney, which is relevant and material document. Although, this document is filed at this stage, no prejudice will be caused to defendants. Considering their relevance, production of this document deserves to be allowed. Resultantly, following order is passed :

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Production of document is permitted.
