

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN S.C.C. NO. 417/2019

The present case is filed by complainant on dated 17.07.2019. It means that, case is more than 6 years old. Perused record it seems that, the matter is pending for steps since 19.08.2022 but complainant and Ld. Advocate for complainant both are not appearing before Court on each date to conduct the matter. Hence, the matter is kept for dismissal order on 10.12.2025. Thereafter, also complainant failed to appear before the court to take effective steps. Today also complainant and Ld. Advocate for complainant called out repeatedly in the first session as well as in second session but they did not appear before Court. Thus, it seems that, complainant is not interested to proceed the matter actively and effectively.

2. Considering the fact and circumstances it seems that, there is no possibility of complainant of appearing and taking effective steps to proceed with the matter. Case is more than 6 years old. The Hon'ble High Court has directed to dispose of old matters as early as possible. Keeping such old unattended matter is unnecessary burden on the Court which hampers the effective work of Court. No fruitful purpose would be served by keeping this unattended matter on record. Considering the entire fact and circumstance on record, it reveals that there is no ground to proceed further. Hence the complaint is dismissed U/s. 256 Code of Criminal Procedure.
