This is an application by defendant for accepting written statement by condoning delay for filing written statement and for setting aside No W.S. order, if any.

2] Perused the application and say. Heard both the Ld. Advocates at length. Perused the record. The defendant has failed to file his written statement within stipulated period. Now he is seeking its condonation for delay. The reason specified in the application for causing delay is Covid-19 pandemic situation and application supported by an affidavit annexed therewith. Plaintiff has denied it. However, the assertions in the affidavit was not countered by counter affidavit. Therefore, there is no reason to disbelieve the statement on oath. It is settled principle of law that, no one should be condemned unheard. It is always desirable to decide the matter on merit by giving a justifiable and lawful opportunity to the party concerned. Therefore, in the interest of justice, the defendant is permitted to file his written statement by condoning delay for filing the same and accordingly No W.S. order, if any against him is set aside.
