

**REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO.372/2024 - ORDER BELOW EXH.23**  
**Dattatray Babaurao Sagaokar Vs. Jotiram Baburao Sagaokar Etc.**  
**CNR No. MHSO2000-1332-2024**

The present application is filed on behalf of plaintiff for issuance of summons to defendant no.4 as per Order V Rule 20 of the CPC.

2. It is notable that the suit is for declaration, measurement and perpetual injunction. The defendant no.4 is claimed to be necessary party to the suit. It is contended by the plaintiff that though a number of types summons was issued to defendant no.4, it cannot be served by ordinary mode of service of summons. Perused the record. The record shows that defendant no.4 namely Amruta Sambhaji Yadav is claimed to be resident of Taluka Ajara, Dist. Kolhapur after her marriage. Despite issuance of summons, it could not be served on defendant no.4 by ordinary mode of service of summons. the present application is supported by affidavit. Hence, it would be just and appropriate to issue summons to defendant no.4 as per Order V Rule 20 of CPC. Resultantly following order is passed.

**ORDER**

1. Issue summons to defendant no.4 by affixing copy thereof in some conspicuous place in Court house and also upon some conspicuous part of house in which the defendant no.4 is known to have last resided.
2. Issue summons to defendant no.4 by an advertisement in a daily news paper circulating in the locality in which the defendant no.4 is last known to have resided.
