2. Perused the record. It reveals that, suit is proceeded without written-statement of defendants. However, since 24/03/2019 plaintiffs are continuously absent. Since then the matter is pending on same stage without any progress. Considering the continuous absence of the plaintiffs, on 18/07/2024 my Ld. Predecessor and on 15/11/2025, 03/12/2025, 06/02/2026 this Court passed orders below Exh. 01 kept the matter for dismissal order. However, despite multiple directions, plaintiffs remained absent and failed to take effective steps. Matter is more than seven years old. Considering all these aspects, it appears that, the plaintiffs have lost their interest to proceed with the matter. Therefore, keeping matter pending furthermore would not serve any purpose. Hence, I pass following order ;

ORDER

1. R.C.S. No. 435/2018 is hereby dismissed in view of O IX R 3 of Code of Civil Procedure.
2. Original documents if any filed on record be preserved for stipulated period as per law.
3. Interim relief, if any, granted earlier, stands vacated.
4. Proceeding is closed.
