Nagnath and others vs Nill

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 01

The present application is filed under the provision of Section 372 of the Indian Succession, 1925 by the petitioner husband and daughters of deceased Laxmibai Nagnath Tarange seeking succession certificate in respect of the amount laying in the fixed deposit receipt accounts in the Bank of Maharashtra, Branch Uruli Kanchan, Taluka Haveli, District Pune.

2. The citation/proclamation vide Exhibits 06 and 09 have been issued. There has been no objection from any quarter of the society.

3. As per the case of petitioners, petitioner No.1 Nagnath is the husband and petitioner Nos. 2 and 3 are the daughters of deceased Laxmibai Nagnath Tarange, who is expired on 26/06/2025 at Village Kumbhej, Taluka Madha, District Solapur. At present, petitioner No. 1 resides at Londhewadi, Taluka Madha, District Solapur. Petitioner No. 2 resides at Galandwadi, Taluka Mohol, District Solapur and petitioner No. 3 resides at Khairewadi, Taluka Madha, District Solapur. Prior to that, petitioner No. 1 Nagnath was residing at Nanaware Wasti, Uruli Kanchan, Taluka Haveli, District Pune. Further, in the name of deceased Laxmibai Nagnath Tarange, petitioner No. 1 has deposited the amount in the scheme of Fixed Deposit in the Bank of Maharashtra, Branch Uruli Kanchan, Taluka Haveli, District Pune. After the death of deceased Laxmibai, total amount of Rs.5,05,008/- (Five Lakh Five Thousand Eight Rupees only) is laying in the fixed deposit receipt account in the name of deceased. There is no other heirs to deceased as well as there is no other kith and kins and near and dear ones to the deceased except the petitioners.

4. Perused the evidence on record at Exhibit 10 and documents vide Exhibit 04 i.e. death certificate of deceased Laxmibai, receipts of bank deposits, Aadhar Cards of the petitioners. If the evidence and documents produced on record are appreciated, it can be seen that the petitioners have made out a case for issuance of succession certificate. Since, there has been no objection from any quarter of the society, therefore, there is no reason to discard the evidence and claim of the petitioners. In the result, this Court inclined to entertain and allow the application as prayed. Hence, order.

ORDER

1. Petition is allowed as prayed.
2. Issue succession certificate in the name of the petitioners on payment of requisite court fees to receive an amount of Rs.5,05,008/- (Five Lakh Five Thousand Eight Rupees only) which is laying in the Fixed Deposit receipt account of Bank of Maharashtra, Branch Uruli Kanchan, Taluka Haveli, District Pune of the deceased Laxmibai Nagnath Tarange referred in Para No. 5.
3. The petitioners to furnish indemnity bond to the tune of the amount of security.
4. On the said compliance, the office of this Court is directed to issue succession certificate in the name of the petitioners in respect of amount mentioned in prayer clause 10 of the petition.
