This application is preferred by respondents seeking adjournment to file the written statement. The respondents submitted that due to examinations they have not possible to prepare written statement and hence they sought adjournment.

This application is strongly resisted by the appellant on the ground that sufficient opportunity is already availed by the respondents to file the written statement. Appellant stated that, near about nine dates are taken by the respondents for to submit written statement and the reasons of examination is not trustworthy reason and therefore he prayed to reject the application.

2. In the application these respondents have specifically stated that the advocate has not possible to prepare written statement due to examination. But on perusal of record it shows that sufficient opportunity is granted to the respondents to file their written statement and in spite of it they failed to file written statement. Granting of opportunity to contest the matter is the basic principle of law and therefore it is just and proper to grant last chance to the respondent. Therefore application deserves to be allowed and I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Last chance is granted to the respondents to file written statement.
