

**Common order below Exh.112 and 113 in
appeal No.27/2022**

1. These applications have been filed by respondent No.1 and 4 for setting aside exparte and no say order passed against them respectively. It is contended by respondent No. 4 that respondent No. 4 has appeared in the present matter on 08/08/2025 and has already filed pursis at exh 47 by adopting say of respondent No. 1 filed at exh 43. It is further averred that matter was remanded back by Hon'ble High court. Therefore. in the interest of justice, no say order passed against respondent No. 4 be aside. Respondent No. 1 affirmed the said contention of respondent No. 4 and averred that say filed by them at exh 43 be treated as their say and prayed to set aside exparte order passed against respondent No.1
2. Perused record. It appears matter is remanded back by Hon'ble High court and after remand, respondent No. 1 and 4 appeared in the present matter. Thereafter fresh notices were issued to all parties and consequently order of exparte and no say was passed against respective parties. Taking into consideration theses circumstance and considering the principle of natural justice, application deserves to be allowed. Say of respondent No. 1 and 4 is already on record. Opportunity should be given to all parties to agitate their claim. Hence formal order of setting aside exparte against respondent no. 1 and no say

order against respondent No. 4 is necessary. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. Applications are allowed.
