::ORDER BELOW EXH.1::

1. In the instant application, the applicant has prayed for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the B.N.S.
2. Mr. V. S. Shinde, learned counsel for the applicant, submitted that the Family Court at Indore, Madhya Pradesh, has issued a non-bailable warrant against the applicant. The Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Indore, has stayed the matter in Criminal Revision No. 45/2024. During the pendency of the said order, efforts are being made to arrest the applicant. He is ready to cooperate with the investigation. Hence, he prayed that anticipatory bail be granted to the applicant.

3. Per contra, Ms. G. M. Lakade, learned A.P.P for the State, submitted that the applicant has not given any details. Further, the record of the case shows that the dispute is pending between the applicant and the deceased in the Family Court. Hence, this Court cannot grant anticipatory bail to the applicant.

4. The applicant has produced the order dated 12/04/2024 passed in Criminal Revision No. 45/2024 by the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Indore. It shows that the applicant assured to pay Rs. 10,000/- per month towards maintenance, and liberty has been given to the wife of the applicant to recover the amount in accordance with law in case of failure of the applicant to pay the maintenance amount. Therefore, warrant if any, issued by the family court can be cancelled by the same court. This court has no jurisdiction to cancel the NBW issued by the family court. Therefore, the applicant has not made out any case for grant of anticipatory bail. In the result, I pass the following order.

ORDER

The application is dismissed.
