

**ORDER BELOW EXH.5 IN CRIMINAL APPEAL NO.05/2025**  
(Tejas Rajkumar Jadhav Vs. Ravindra Kulkarni & anr.)

01. Heard Ld. Advocate of appellant. Perused application supported by affidavit and the record.

02. This is appeal against the conviction imposed for the offence punishable U/s.138 of N.I. Act. It is submitted by the Ld. Adv. for the appellant that, the applicant was convicted U/s. 138 of N.I.Act and sentenced to suffer S.I. for six months and to pay compensation of Rs.16,43,840/- i.d., he shall suffer S.I. for two months. So, he has filed this appeal along with this application. According to him, he has not committed any offence. He has confidence to be acquitted. He is well known young businessman, permanent resident of given address and ready to abide all conditions. So application be allowed.

03. Considering the nature of the offence, following order is passed in the interest of justice.

**ORDER**

1. Application is allowed.

2. In result, as per provisions of S.389 of Cr.P.C., sentence of appellant/accused is suspended till hearing of this appeal on depositing of 25% of the compensation amount and on furnishing of his P.R. of Rs.25,000/- with one or two surety/ies in like amount. Matter to proceed accordingly.
