

Order below Exh. no. 08 in Sessions Case no. 28/2024
(State of Maharashtra Vs. Yash Suresh Shinde)
(CNR no. MHST0010007462024)

1. This is an application filed by accused no. 1 Yash Suresh Shinde for releasing him on bail. In view of order below of Exh. 01 dated 16/09/2025 non-bailable warrant has been issued to accused no. 1, in execution of which he is produced before this Court at about 2.00 p.m.

2. It is the contention of learned advocate that the accused is sole earning member of his family. Henceforth he will be abide by every condition of the Court and will remain present on each date. Hence this application.

3. Learned Additional Public prosecutor has strongly objected this application by submitting that the presence of accused is secured after issuance of non-bailable warrant. No grounds are mentioned showing reason for absence. Hence learned additional Public Prosector has prayed for rejecting this application.

4. Perused record. Charge-sheet has been filed against accused with an allegation of committing of an offence punishable under Section 394, 397, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code on the basis of C.R. no. 536/2023 of Satara City Police Station. Case is committed and it reveals that meanwhile accused was present on 04/07/2024 and 04/10/2024. However thereafter the accused remained absent and even failed to comply continuation of bail, in result of which non-bailable warrant was issued against him. Now case is for framing of

charge and considering the submission made by the accused that he will abide every bail condition and will remain present on each date, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1 The application is allowed as follows.
- 2 Accused Yash Suresh Shinde, be released on bail on his executing P. B. and S.B. of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousands Only), with one or two surety/ies in the like amount on following conditions:-
 - a) The accused shall not prolong the hearing of this case due his absence.
 - b) The accused shall not pressurize the victim and witnesses and shall not tamper the evidence.
 - c) The accused shall not contact the victim in any manner.
- 3 The breach of any of the condition will lead to cancellation of bail.
