**CHARGE**

I, J. S. Bhatia, Ad-hoc Additional Sessions Judge, Satara, hereby charge you:

1. Yash Suresh Shinde  
Age: 24 Years, Occu: labour  
R/o. 211, Ravivar Peth, Satara  
Taluka and District Satara

2. Akshay Madhukar Tupe  
Age: 22 Years, Occu: labour  
R/o – 116, Flat no. 4 Kachhi heights,  
Budhwar Peth, Satara  
Taluka and District Satara

As follows -

1) That you both accused on 11/07/2023 at about 06.30 p.m. in Telli Khadda, Radhika road, Satara in furtherance of your common intention, committed robbery by voluntarily causing hurt to the informant Indalsing Ratansing Chitodia by assaulting on his back and waist by sickle as well as fist blows and removed Rs. 500/-, mobile handset and gold earrings of the informant so also smother him and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 394 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

2) Furthermore, on the same date, time and place, you both accused in furtherance of your common intention were prepared to commit said robbery with deadly weapon like sickle and caused hurt to the informant Indalsing Ratansing Chitodia while committing robbery and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 397 read with

Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

3) Furthermore, on the same date, time and place, you both accused in furtherance of your common intention intentionally insulted the informant Indalsing Ratansing Chitodia so also the surrounding people who were called for help by the informant, by abusing verbally and thereby gave provocation to him intending or knowing it to be likely that such provocation will cause him to break the public peace and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 504 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

4) Furthermore, that on the same date, time and place, you both accused in furtherance of your common intention committed criminal intimidation by threatening the informant Indalsing Ratansing Chitodia so also to the surrounding people who were called for help by the informant, with intention to cause alarm to them and that you have thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

I hereby direct that you be tried by this Court on said charge.
