1. Gone through the application, say and documents.
2. The hearing has begun by examining 2 witnesses. The accused remained absent and therefore, the NBW was issued. In execution of NBW, the accused came to be arrested and detained in the MCR. Therefore, present application seeking bail.
3. As noted above, the hearing has already begun by examining 2 witnesses who are not supporting the prosecution. Be it as it may, the accused has shown his readiness and willingness to remain present on each date so fixed. Thus, considering the peculiar facts, more particularly considering the fact that the accused was previously on bail, he deserves to be enlarged on bail.
4. The prosecution, at the same time has filed an application (Exh.42) thereby seeking forfeiting of earlier bail bond. Thus, considering the grant of fresh bail, following

order ;-

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.40) is allowed.
2. Accused Akash @ Gundya Dnyaneshwar Kapale be released on bail in connection with C.R.No.198/2019 registered with Satara City Police Station for the offence punishable u/s. 394, 341, 504, 506 r/w 34 of IPC and section 3(1)(2), 3(2) & 3(4) of MCOC Act, on furnishing by him P.B. and S.B. of Rs.25,000/- with one or two sureties of like amount on following conditions ;
 - (i) Accused shall not leave the limits of Satara city without prior permission of the Court.
 - (ii) The accused shall remain present on each date of hearing so fixed. In case of default, the bail granted to accused stands cancelled without further reference to the Court.
 - (iii) He shall not commit similar nature of offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses and evidence in any manner.

3. The application (Exh.42) filed by the prosecution stands allowed thereby forfeiting the earlier bail bond.
4. The accused to furnish the equivalent cash of earlier bail bond.
