

Order below Exh. 01 in M.A.C.P M.A. No. 105/2021

(Anil Suresh Vibhute and another Vs. Ganesh Suresh Vibhute)
(CNR-MHST01001776-2021)

1. This detailed accident report is filed by Satara Taluka Police Station in reference to C.R. no. 271/2021 registered under Section 304-A, 279, 337, 338 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 184, 3(1)/181 and 146/196 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. As per said report on 03/06/2021 at about 2.00 a.m. near village Varye, Taluka District Satara on Limbkhind fly over bridge and lane no. 1, a motorcycle driver of Hero Honda Deluxe Motorcycle no. MH-11 BP-8718 found dead after colliding with the divider of lane no. 1. After inquiry, name of said motorcycle driver revealed as Anil Suresh Vibhute. Accordingly, the patrolling police Naik Bakkal no. 1075 Samir Balkrushan Mahangade lodged FIR against deceased Anil Suresh Vibhute.

2. In view of order below Exh. 1 dated 05/01/2021, notice was issued to the legal representatives and dependents of deceased Anil Suresh Vibhute. Accordingly, his father Suresh Vithoba Vibhute appeared on 06/01/2026 and filed self attested copy of his Adhar Card no. 2737 9114 6433 in support of his identity. He has submitted an application at Exh. 4 stating that he does not want to claim any compensation for death of Anil Suresh Vibhute. So also, Chhaya Suresh Vibhute, mother of deceased also appeared today and filed self attested copy of her Adhar Card no. 2446 0430 3035 in support of her identity. She has also submitted an application at Exh. 5 stating that she does not want to proceed with this application and does not

want to claim any compensation. Both have prayed to the Tribunal to close this proceeding.

3. As per investigation report it seems that the vehicle was not duly insured on the date of accident. It was insured only for the period from 17/11/2014 to 16/11/2025. The date of accident is 03/06/2021 and the vehicle was registered in the name of Ganesh Suresh Vibhute, who is the brother of deceased Anil Suresh Vibhute. In view of these circumstances, as the dependents of deceased Anil Suresh Vibhute do not intend to proceed with this accident claim application, it is required to be disposed of. Accordingly, this miscellaneous application is disposed of. Proceeding is closed.
