

ORDER BELOW EXH. 24 IN M.A.C.P. NO. 7/2019
(CNR.NO.MHST01004097-2018)

(Sunil Devdhar Vs. Nitin Nanaware & Ors.)

This is an application filed by applicant for condonation of delay for bringing legal representatives of original applicant Sunil Devdhar on record.

2] It is contended that, on 21/10/2020 original applicant Sunil Devdhar died. It is further contended that he died in the pandemic situation of COVID-19 and they were not having knowledge about the bringing legal representatives of deceased person. So, there is delay of 2 years for bringing legal representatives of original applicant Sunil Devdhar on record.

3] Respondents filed say and strongly opposed to the present application.

4] Heard learned counsel for applicant and respondents. Perused record.

5] It appears that, application has been filed on 13/01/2023. Applicant has filed copy of death certificate of original applicant Sunil Devdhar at Exh. 32. On perusal of death certificate it appears that original applicant Sunil Devdhar died on 21/10/2020. It shows that delay caused to bring on record legal representatives of original

applicant Sunil Devdhar. However, reasons mentioned in the application are found justifiable. Hence, in the interest of justice, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Delay is condoned.
- 3] No order as to cost.
