The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the Virtual Court and a fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per Section 208 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

Accusation is explained to Ld. Counsel for accused appearing on behalf of accused. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for accused that accused wants to pay the fine imposed. In view of the same, accused is convicted for the offence **u/s 112/183 M.V Act, 1988.**
