Today the matter is fixed for evidence. Despite issuance of witness summons, the prosecution agency is not securing the presence of witnesses. It is the responsibility of the prosecution to secure the presence of witnesses. Under such circumstances, giving stray applications for issuance of witness summons to one or two witnesses, would not only consume the time of Court but delay the proceeding. Therefore, the prosecution is directed to submit a Schedule of fixing Sessions for 3 to 4 days, so that the witnesses can be examined at the earliest and the case can be disposed off at the earliest. Hence, the Public Prosecutor shall produce the Schedule of Trial for recording evidence today only. The learned Public Prosecutor shall also endeavour to secure the presence of witnesses by pursuing the concerned police station or the serving officer, after the witness summonses are issued by this Court. If the prosecution is found least interested in conducting the prosecution, as mentioned above, appropriate order will be passed.
