ORDER BELOW EXH.13

1. Heard. Gone through the application, say and documents.
2. In short the prosecution story is that, the Satara Taluka police station was investigating the A.D. No. 78 of 2023. During the investigation, it was revealed that, the accused Nos. 1 and 2 were having extra marital affair in which the deceased Sharad i.e. husband of accused No.2 Dipali was causing interruption and therefore, the accused persons eliminated the deceased.
3. The Ld. A.P.P. for the State by filing say (Exh.05) strongly opposed the application. It is contended that, there is statement of witnesses who lastly seen the deceased in the company of accused persons. The accused, in memorandum statement, produced the motorcycle of deceased. The witnesses and accused are from same place. There is possibility that, the accused may win over the witnesses and tamper with the

evidence. Thus, prayed for rejection of the application.

4. With the help of ld. APP and advocate for accused, gone through the charge-sheet. The trial is based on circumstances. There are statements of two witnesses who have seen the deceased in the company of accused. However, their statements and its evidentiary value will be tested during the trial. The charge-sheet does not contain any other incriminating material except the statements of witnesses who lastly seen the deceased in the company of accused as well as recovery of motorcycle. Be it as it may, while considering the plea of bail, the merits or roaring inquiry is not expected.

5. The accused persons came to be arrested on 11.08.2023 and since then, they are behind the bars. The presence of accused can be secured by imposing suitable conditions. The investigation has already been completed followed by charge-sheet. The trial will take its own time to commence and conclude. Pre-trial detention is not warranted. Thus, considering the peculiar facts, following order:

O R D E R

- 1 The application is allowed.
- 2 The accused Manisha @ Dipali Dada Bichukale, be released on P.R. and S.B. of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) in connection with the C.R. No. 359/2023 registered with Satara Taluka Police Station with one or two sureties of like amount on following terms and conditions;

Conditions

- (i) The accused shall not approach the informant or prosecution witnesses who are acquainted with the facts of the case.
- (ii) He shall not tamper or hamper with the prosecution witnesses and evidence in any manner.
