

ORDER BELOW APPLICATION (EXH. 63) IN
SPECIAL CASE (ATRO) NO. 23 OF 2018
CNR MHST01002761-2018
(State of Maharashtra Vs. Vikas Baburao patil)

As per directions in orders dated 07.11.2020, 18.12.2020 and 01.01.2021 below applications (Exhs. 59, 62 and 3A respectively) the first informant was expected to remain present and advance arguments, if any, on the pending application (Exh.3A). However, on last 3 dates she is continuously absent. Today she has kept the present application on the table of clerk of this Court. By the present application she seeks adjournment on the ground of illness. The application is, however, silent regarding particulars of her illness, if any. The application is also silent as to how many days are required for her presence before the Court. The available prima facie facts and circumstances of the case show that on one or the other pretext she is trying to protract hearing of the application. In fact the application deserves to be rejected. However, in order to decide the pending application on merit and in order to give her one more fair opportunity adjournment sought is granted as a last chance with direction to her to remain present on the next date and proceed with hearing of the pending application on the next date without fail, failing which appropriate order will be passed on the pending application in her absence.
