

Order passed below Exh.54 in Sessions Case No.137 of 2018.

(CNR No.MHST01-003279-2018)

01. Present application is filed by Ganesh Lahu Bhondave through his Advocate to accept cash security instead of surety till certain period.

02. According to accused, the bail order is passed by the Sessions Court and accused was directed to furnish personal bond and surety of Rs.50,000/-. Accused is in jail. His wife and children could not get the surety as per the order of the Court. Hence, present application to release the accused on cash security.

03. According to learned A.P.P., he has no objection to release the accused on cash security for a period of three months with a direction to accused that, he should furnish the regular bail within three months from the date of order.

04. Heard learned Advocate for accused. Gone through the say of learned A.P.P. On perusal of record, it came to my notice that, bail order is passed below Exh.21 on 22.11.2018. From the record, it reveals that, in spite of the order of the Court, accused could not furnish the bail. From the record, it reveals that, accused is resident of village Saidapaur. As learned A.P.P. has no objection to accept the cash security of accused instead of surety, I think that, following order will meet the ends of justice. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application at Exh.54 is allowed.
2. Accused by name Ganesh Lahu Bhondave be released on cash security of Rs.50,000/- till 18.03.2019. Accused to furnish regular bail at the most till 18.03.2019.
3. As accused is in jail, he to furnish personal bond after he is released from jail.
