

ORDER BELOW EXH. 144 IN REG. CIVIL SUIT NO. 31 OF 1997
(CNR No.MHST05-000031-1997)

The present application has been filed by the third party namely Sou. Suman Baburao Pawar contending that she has appointed Subhash Madhukar Londhe as her power of attorney look after the work of the present proceeding. It is alleged that defendant No. 1 is causing trouble to the power of attorney holder namely Subhash Madhukar Londhe. Defendant No. 1 is threatening the power of attorney holder and also giving abuses in the Court premises.

02. On the count of aforesaid grudge and complaint, the power of attorney holder has moved the present application requesting that the strict action may kindly be taken against defendant No. 1.

03. The say of defendant No. 1 is called for. He has denied all the allegations levelled against him by power of attorney holder of Suman Baburao Pawar. He states that the power of attorney itself is not valid as such it is only notarized and it is made on insufficient stamp paper.

04. It is pertinent to note that this court has rejected the application (Exh.136) filed by Suman Baburao Pawar through her power of attorney holder Subhash Madhukar Londhe through which she has requested to implead her as a party to the suit. In such circumstances, the power of attorney standing in the name of Subhash

Madhukar Londhe has stood extinguished automatically so far as the present litigation is concerned.

05. Again if at all the power of attorney holder Subhash Madhukar Londhe had been threatened and abused in the court premises and outside of the court hall, then Subhash Madhukar Londhe can file criminal complaint against defendant No. 1 or he may lodge the F.I.R. Therefore, I do not find any substance in the application. Hence, the application requires to be rejected. Resultantly, I pass the following order.

ORDER

The application is rejected.
