

Order Below Exh.15 in Spl.C.S.No.47/2019

1. The present application is filed by defendant no.2 society i.e. defendant no. 2A and 2B for setting aside “No W.S.” order on the ground that at the relevant time society and its officers were busy in the crushing season of society. Similarly, as there are more than 700 similar suits it was difficult to arrange for documents for filing written statement. Accordingly, it is prayed to allow application. Despite opportunity plaintiff not filed say.

2. Perused the application and record. Record shows suit summons duly served on defendant no. 2A and 2B on 4-4-2019 and they appeared on 15-6-2019. In my considered view, considering the reasons stated in the application and further considering the valuable right of defendant to take defence it would be justifiable to set aside “No W.S.” order. Hence, the following order:-

Order

1. The defendant no.2 i.e. 2A and 2B permitted to file written statement.
2. Defendant no.2 shall bear cost of present application.
