State Vs. Jitender & Anr.

U.S. 318(4), 61(2) BNS

P.S. Cyber Crime, District Kurukshetra.

Present: Shri Saksham, APP for the State.  
Accused Jitender and Dharmender in custody.

The above named accused persons booked under Sections 318(4), 61(2) BNS have been produced in custody before the undersigned, functioning as the Ilaqua Magistrate along with an application seeking remand to judicial custody of accused Jitender Kumar and Dharmender Singh for a period of 14 days.

2. In compliance with the provisions of Section 47(1) of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), the Arresting Officer has prepared the arrest memos. Grounds of arrest have been duly communicated to the accused persons produced before the undersigned in written by the IO accordingly the compliance of Section 47 of BNSS and the judgment of *Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Mihir Rajesh Shah Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors. 2025 LiveLaw SC 1066* has been duly made.

3. Further, the Investigating Officer has complied with Section 53 of the BNSS by ensuring that the arrested persons underwent the required medico-legal examination. No fresh injuries have been reported.

4. The identities of the accused persons have been verified through identity cards in the form of [AADHAR Cards], duly signed by the accused persons. Accordingly, this Court is satisfied that the individuals taken into custody is the same persons as named in the Arrest Memos. Additionally, a checklist specifying the grounds for arrest has been appended to the case file.

5. Upon perusal of the said checklist, this Court is prima facie satisfied that the arrest of the accused was justified and

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necessary (i) to prevent the accused persons from tempering with evidence and influencing witness (ii) to prevent the risk of flight.

6. After perusal of the record it is seen that the police have prima facie found the role of accused person in the commission of offences under Section **318(4), 61(2) of BNS.**

7. Accordingly, the prayer for remanding the accused to 14 days judicial custody is found justified. Accordingly, accused persons Jitender Kumar and Dharmender Singh are hereby remanded to judicial custody and are directed to be kept in judicial custody in District Jail Kurukshetra and be produced before the Court on **03.06.2026** through VC. Challan is also awaited for the date fixed. Notice to SHO/IO concerned in this regard be also issued for the date fixed.
