The present application has been filed by the plaintiffs for the purpose of seeking amendment by invoking the provisions of Order VI Rule 17 of the Civil Procedure Code.

02. The say of the defendants is called for. The defendants have resisted the application on the ground that the plaintiffs have filed the present application after huge delay. Therefore, the defendants submit that the present application be kindly rejected.

03. Perused the case. The suit is for hearing. Though the present suit is for hearing, there is no provision that amendment application cannot be filed at this stage. Proposed amendment is not going to prejudice the defendants nor it is going to change the nature of suit. Moreover, the proposed amendment is necessary to avoid the multiplicity of the proceedings. Thus, I pass the following order.

ORDER

2. The plaintiffs to carry out the amendment within 14 days from today.
