ORDER BELOW EXH.62

In view of the facts and circumstances, the third party having purchased property in undivided share ought to be made party to the proceedings.

However the darkhast which is sent to the TILR for partition, if called back, will cause setback to the partition being complied at the earliest. Hence it would be appropriate if the amendment to make the third party, party to the suit is carried out in the proceedings, as and where it is. It would save a lot of time. Hence application partly allowed. Plaintiff to add the third party as party judgment debtor to the darkhast. The TILR is directed to permit the plaintiff to carry out the amendment to include the third party and consider the third party while effecting the partition in shoe of defendant concerned.
