

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH. 13 IN L.R. NO. 5/2018

Respondent No. 2 has moved the present application for setting aside 'No W.S.' order passed against him, contending therein that, due to some technical ground delay has been caused and as respondent No. 3 has failed to file his W.S. within time and so, 'No W.S.' order has passed against it. Now, respondent No. 3 has requested for setting aside the 'No W.S.' order and taking his W.S. on record.

On perusal of record, it appears that, 'No W.S' order has been passed against respondent No. 3 on 26.04.2019. Considering facts that, rights of parties have been involved, an opportunity needs to be given to the respondent No. 3, who is government body to contest the proceeding on merit. Hence, the following order:

O R D E R

1. Application is allowed subject to costs of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) and 'No W.S.' order passed against respondent No. 3 is hereby set aside.
2. W.S. filed by respondent No. 3 be taken on record after payment of costs.
