That order was not challenged by the plaintiff/applicant. Therefore, the plaintiff cannot raise objection that, "Section 295 of Indian Succession Act, 1925" is applicable only for the probate or letter of administration.

4. Now the civil application is converted in civil suit, therefore, the plaintiff has to do compliance as a suit. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed. In the result, I pass the following order.
