

**Order below Exh.83 in RCS No.8/2017**

01. This application is made by the plaintiffs to make amendment in order of temporary injunction below Exh.5 in para No.5, 13, as mentioned in this application.

02. Read say of learned advocate for the defendants. Heard to the both sides.

03. The learned advocate for the plaintiffs argued that in order below Exh.5 some arithmetical error arised and that error can be corrected as per Section 152 of the CPC. He argued that para No.5 and para No.13 of the order be corrected.

04. Ld. Advocate for the defendants argued that the observation is given by the Court is correct and there is no any accidental slip or omission in that order. He argued that action of contempt of Court be taken against the present plaintiffs. Accordingly he argued to reject the application.

05. I have gone through order below Exh.5 in paras which are pointed by learned advocate for the plaintiffs with the contents of present application. It does not appear any clerical or arithmetical mistake or even it is not accidental slip because order below Exh.5 is speaking order, therefore, there is no force in the argument of learned advocate for the plaintiffs.

06. That order is of temporary injunction and not final order and it will not affect the merit of the final case. Hence, application is liable to be rejected. Therefore, I pass the following order:

**ORDER**

Application Exh.83 stands rejected.
