ORDER BELOW EXH. C-5.

1. The application is filed by non applicant insurance company for exhibiting the insurance policy and terms and conditions and reading them in evidence as well as to allow their production.
2. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has submitted his say overleaf of the present application. It is submitted by the applicant that, the copy of insurance policy is admitted but the copy of terms and conditions is not admitted as number of the vehicle is not mentioned in it.
3. Heard learned Advocates.
4. Learned Advocate for the party seeking permission under this application, argued that the documents are relevant to the matter under enquiry. If the documents are given exhibit numbers and read in evidence, it will cause no prejudice to other party. The said documents

will be helpful to decide the matter on merits. As per the provisions of law, it is necessary that the documents produced at any stage of the proceedings are to be received in evidence. Thus, the application is to be allowed.

5. It is for the Court to decide whether the documents available are relevant to the matter under enquiry. The documents are to be produced by a party along with the plaint or written statement. If a party wants to rely on certain documents, it is for the party to produce such documents on record at the earliest possible opportunity. Allowing mere production of documents and giving exhibit numbers to those documents or admitting them in evidence is different. In view of these reasons, at this stage, mere production of the document is to be allowed. Resultantly, the application is liable to be partly allowed. Hence, the following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1) The application is partly allowed to the extent of production of documents.
- 2) Insurance policy is only be exhibited.
- 3) Parties to take note of this order.
