

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH. 15 IN S.C.C. NO. 311 OF 2019.

Read application and say Exh. 27. The matter was filed in the year 2019 and still the matter is pending without progress. Considering object of the provision of interim compensation and provision for repayment at the conclusion of trial, if it results into acquittal, there is no legal hurdle to grant the application to the extent of 20% of cheque amount. The innocence of accused will be the subject matter of trial and it can not be decided at this stage as submitted by accused in reply. There is no legal prejudice to the accused. Thus, considering amount of cheque and nature of proceeding following order is passed.

- O R D E R -

1. Accused is hereby directed to pay interim compensation to the extent of 20% of cheque amount within one month.
02. On failure to comply the order, the complainant shall take necessary steps to recover the amount as a land revenue.
03. If the case resulted into acquittal, the complainant shall refund the amount to the accused within 30 days of judgment.
