



**Common Order below Exh. 1 and 15 in S.C.C. No.182/2024
(May Mahalaxmi Krushi Seva Kendra Thr Pravin Ganpatrao Bankar
Vs. May Mangalmurti Krushi Seva Udayg Thr Nikhil Dilip Jagtap)**

The complainant, accused along with their advocates are present before the Court and filed withdrawal pursis (Exh.15) and submits that, the accused has paid entire amount under cheque. Therefore, the complainant dose not want to proceed further with the matter. Perused withdrawal pursis (Exh. 15) and proceeding. I have personally verified from the complainant who states that, he wants to withdraw the complaint. Hence, in the interest of justice, I pass following order,

ORDER

1. The complaint is hereby disposed of as withdrawn in view of withdrawal pursis (Exh.15).
2. The accused is discharged of the offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act.
3. Warrant against accused is cancelled and recalled. Inform police accordingly.
4. Court fees be returned as per rules.
