This is an application under section 503 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed by the applicant for interim custody of Gold Mani Mangalsutra weighted 5 grams (hereinafter referred as said muddemal). It is contended by the applicant that, the said muddemal is owned by her and it is seized by Karad City Police in Crime No.676/2025 and it is in their custody. The said muddemal snatched by thief at the time when she was walking on road. She wears the said muddemal for functions. If the said muddemal is kept idle in the custody of police, it will get damaged due to it's non use. It is contended that, if the seized muddemal is given in her interim custody, she will abide all terms and conditions imposed upon her by the Hon'ble Court and produce the vehicle as when required by the Court. Thus, the applicant prayed for the interim custody of the aforesaid vehicle on indemnity bond.

02. Say of Ld. APP, IO was called on this application.

03. IO filed his say and contended that, he has no objection to take the custody of the said muddemal to the applicant.

04. Ld. APP for state filing his say and objected the application. It is contended that, if the said muddemal handed over to the applicant, she may modify or change the appearance of it or

transfer its ownership. Briefly on these ground, he prayed that, the application be rejected.

05. Heard Ld. APP and Ld. Advocate for the applicant. Perused the documents on record.

06. Applicant has produced on record, copy of FIR at Exh.3/1, verified copy of applicant's Adhar-card at Exhibit-3/2 and affidavit affirming about losing of purchase receipt of said muddemal at Exh.3/3. On perusal of the same, it is seen that applicant is the owner of the seized vehicle. Till today, except the applicant, no other person has claimed for that vehicle.

07. Hence, considering the entire discussion made in above paragraphs, I am of the opinion, if the said muddemal is kept unused and unattended then, it will get damaged. The Applicant has shown her ownership over the said muddemal by filing the affidavit. The applicant has stated in the application that, she is ready to abide the conditions if any, imposed by the Court. So also the vehicle is not claimed by any other person. Therefore, if the above said muddemal is given in the custody of the applicant on necessary conditions, then the purpose of trial can be very well served. By taking into consideration all these aspects, I proceed to pass the following :-

-: **ORDER** :-

01. The application is allowed.

02. Interim custody of vehicle of Gold Mani Mangalsutra weighted 5 grams be given to the applicant **Dhanashri Hanmant Kumbhar** on execution of indemnity bond in the sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rs. One Lac Fifty Thousand only) till further orders and on following conditions :-

- a) She shall keep the said muddemal in good condition; and shall not change the appearance or modify it;
 - b) She shall not, in any way, transfer ownership of the said muddemal to any third person;
 - c) She shall produce the said muddmela before the Court and shall make it available to the Investigating Officer, as and when required.
03. On executing indemnity bond, P.S.O. Karad City to take colored photographs of the same, taken from different angles clearly and to be attested by applicant at her own expenses and to send the same to the Court and to handover custody of seized muddemal to applicant by drawing necessary Panchanama.
04. Police Station, Karad City is directed to allow the applicant to execute the indemnity bond, snap photographs of the seized muddemal in C.R.No.676/2025 or to make any other necessary compliance at their office.
05. Yadi be issued to Karad City Police Station.
