



**Order Below Exh. 177 in RCS No. 214/2009
(Jijaba Tukaram Bhingardev Vs. Madhav Ganesh Kulkarni)**

1. This application is filed on behalf of the legal representatives of deceased plaintiff for condonation of delay of One year Two months in bringing legal representatives of deceased plaintiff. It is contended that, during the pendency of the suit the plaintiff died on 27/10/2024. Legal Representative of deceased plaintiff are necessary parties. Due to no knowledge of the proceeding therefore the plaintiff could not file application for bringing Legal Representative of deceased plaintiff on record within limitation and delay is caused which needs to be condoned. Therefore, the plaintiff prayed to allow the application.

2. Other side objected the application by filing say. It is contended that, reason mentioned in the application is not just and proper. Therefore, other side prayed to reject the application or impose heavy costs.

3. Heard both sides.

4. Perused the record. It is contention of the applicant that, the plaintiff died on 27/10/2024. It is the contention of the

applicant that, due to no knowledge of proceeding, therefore, applicants could not file application for bringing Legal Representative of deceased plaintiff on record within limitation. Therefore, considering the reason there is sufficient cause for condonation of delay. Hence, in the interest of justice, application deserves to be allowed. In the result, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The applications at Exh. 177 is allowed.
2. Delay in bringing legal representatives of deceased plaintiff on record is condoned.
