



**Common Order Below Exh. 31 and 32 in S.C.C. No. 1699/2018
(Shriram City Union Finance Vs. Ramchandra Suresh Jadhav)**

1. The accused Ramchandra Suresh Jadhav has filed these applications for releasing him.
2. Complainant opposed the application by filing say.
3. Heard both sides.
4. Perused the record. Record shows that, the accused allegedly has committed offence punishable Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act. Record also shows that the accused remained absent. Hence, NBW was issued against the accused. Now, the accused is ready to remain present on each date. However, the accused has breached earlier order granting bail and also breached his PR bond. Therefore, the amount of said PR bond is forfeited and credited to the Government. Learned counsel for the accused submits that, minimum penalty to be awarded. As the accused is ready to remain present, there is no necessity to keep his behind bar. In the result, I pass following order,

ORDER

1. The accused Ramchandra Suresh Jadhav be released on furnishing fresh P.B. and S.B, of Rs, 15,000/- or cash surety of Rs.3,000/-. Amount of forfeited PR bond is remitted as per Section 491(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
2. The accused is directed remain present on each date till conclusion of trial.
