ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO. 01

Accused Rohan Mahesh Vaske is present before me. He is represented by learned Adv. H.R.Kale. Accused is charged with the offence punishable under section 69, 115(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 324(4) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023. I have perused the charge sheet and all documents filed along with it. On perusal of all above facts, it can be seen that, there is a sufficient ground to frame the charge for the offence punishable under section 69 of the Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023. The offence punishable under section 69 is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions. All the copies of police report and other documents as specified in section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been supplied to the accused. Therefore, I am of the view that, in order to avoid delay, the case needs to be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Karad as early as possible. Hence, the following order;

ORDER

- 1) The case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court at Karad.
- 2) The accused shall remain present before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, at Karad on 09/04/2026.
- 3) The Investigating Officer of Karad Taluka Police Station, is hereby directed that, the record of the case, the documents and articles, which are to be produced in evidence shall be sent to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at Karad.
- 4) The Karad Taluka Police station is hereby directed to produce muddemal property, if any in the

Hon'ble Court of Session on or before 09/04/2026,
positively.

- 5) Issue notice to the public prosecutor about the information of committal of the case to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at Karad.
