



COMMITTAL ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN R.C.C. NO. 431/2024
**(The State Of Maharashtra-Talbid Police Station Vs. Prathmesh
Pralhad Pawar)**

1. The officer-in-charge of Police Station, Talbid after the completion of the investigation in CR No. 82/2024 for offence punishable under Section 376(2)(N), 323, 504 and 506 of Indian Penal Code has filed report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The offence punishable under Section 376(2)(N) of Indian Penal Code is exclusively triable by Hon'ble Sessions Court. Therefore, the case has to be committed to Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Karad.

3. The accused is bail out. The accused and advocate are present before the Court. Copies of police report and other documents as specified in Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure have been supplied to accused. I have explained the accused about the provision of Free Legal Aid available to him. I asked him, whether he desire to avail Free Legal Aid. He stated that, he has own arrangement for their defence before Hon'ble

Sessions Judge by engaging advocate. The intimation of next date is given to the accused and advocate. Pursis (Exh.9) is also filed by the accused. Therefore, the case will have to be committed to the Court of Sessions. Hence, I pass following order,

ORDER

1. The case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Karad.
2. Accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Karad on 18/04/2026 at 11.00 a.m. without fail.
3. The record of the case, the documents and articles (Muddemal) which are to be produced in evidence, shall be sent and produced before the Hon'ble Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Karad.
4. Issue letter to the Investigating Officer of this crime for producing Muddemal, if any, before the Hon'ble Court of Additional Sessions, Karad on or before 18/04/2026 at 11:00 a.m.
5. The Public Prosecutor shall be notified of the commitment of the case to the Hon'ble Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Karad.
