



ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 1

(Passed on 02nd day of June, 2026)

1. The application is filed by the applicant for interim custody of **Mahindra Scorpio** bearing registration no. **MH 14 BY 0909**. (hereinafter referred to as the “vehicle”). The said vehicle was seized by the Police Station, Panchgani in Crime No. 127/2026 for the offence punishable under section 65(e) of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act.
2. Heard the learned advocate for the applicant and learned A. P. P. Perused the record and documents attached in the nature of F.I.R., copy of registration certificate, copy of insurance papers and copy of aadhar card of the applicant. The material placed on record indicates that, **Rahul Madhukar Deshmukh** is the registered owner of the said vehicle.
3. The reply filed by the investigating officer is not suggesting that detention of said vehicle is utmost necessary for the purpose of further investigation. Therefore, as regards to the apprehension of the learned A.P.P. proper conditions could be imposed on the applicant. Moreover, if the said vehicle is kept lying with the police station it would also become junk day by day. Furthermore, the applicant has satisfied the requisites laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *(Sunderbhai Ambalal Desai V/s. State Of Gujarat, Special Leave Petition (crl.) 2745 of 2002)*.

Therefore, it would be just and proper to handover interim custody of the said vehicle to the applicant. In the result, following order is passed:

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The interim custody of **Mahindra Scorpio** bearing registration no. **MH 14 BY 0909** seized in Crime No. 127/2026 for the offence punishable under section 65(e) of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act be given to the applicant on furnishing his bond of Rs. 5,00,000 (Five Lakh Rupees only).
3. Applicant shall bind himself that -
 - a. He shall not sell or create third party interest in the said vehicle till final disposal of the case.
 - b. He shall not make any changes in the parts of the vehicle till final disposal of the case.
 - c. He shall produce said vehicle before the investigating officer and before the Court in any matter arising out of above said crime, as and when directed.
4. The investigating officer is hereby directed to take photographs of the said vehicle and prepare detail panchanama of the same which shall be countersigned by the applicant and submit these documents along with chargesheet.
