#### **Order Below Bail Application**

Accused moved present bail applications under Section 480 of BNSS 2023. Alleged offence has registered against the accused under Sections 118(1)115(2), 352, 351(2)(3) and 324(4) of BNS 2023.

02. Learned A.P.P. Shri. S. P. Kanse has filed his say on overleaf of the present application. Heard the learned A.P.P. and Ld. Advocate for the accused at length. Perused the bail application.

03. Ld. A.P.P. has opposed the said application on the ground that offence is non-bailable. Accused and informant are from same village. If the accused released on bail, then accused will pressurize the witnesses and may be fled away. Therefore, learned A.P.P. prayed for rejecting the present bail application.

04. Advocate for the accused submitted that, the accused is innocent and have not committed any offence. Learned advocate for accused further submitted that, accused will co-operate the investigating machinery as and when required. Accused is permanently resided at Khamkarwadi, Tal. Jaoli, Dist. Satara. Accused will obey the terms and conditions, while passing bail order. Considering this aspect leniency should be shown while deciding the bail application. Hence, he prayed to release the accused on conditional bail.

Perused the bail application and the say filed by learned A.P.P.

05. There is no propriety in keeping the accused persons behind bar. Thus, the apprehension raised by the learned A.P.P. would also needs to be considered. Considering the age of accused persons, nature of offence and punishment awarded for alleged offence it is just, proper and reasonable to release the accused on conditional bail. Though the offence is cognizable, non-bailable, but triable by this Court. Hence, it would be just and proper to enlarged the accused on bail subject to certain conditions. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

**ORDER**

01. The application is allowed.
02. Accused Namely Santosh Sopan Pawar be released on furnishing P.B. and S.B. of Rs.15,000/- with one surety in the like amount.
03. Accused is further directed to remain present before Court during trial on each date.
04. Accused shall submitted the detail address, phone number of their relatives.
05. In the event of breach of any of the above conditions, the prosecution would be at liberty to approach for cancellation of bail.
