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ORDER BELOW EXH.1

ORDER

- 1) The complaint stands disposed off as withdrawn in terms of composition of compromise Exhibit-21 and award at Exh.22.
- 2) Accused is acquitted of the offence p/u/s. 138 of the N.I.Act.
- 3) Bail bond of accused if he has furnished any stands cancelled.
- 4) Original Cheque be returned to the accused.
- 5) The Court fee be refunded to the complainant as per rules.
