ORDER

1. This is an application filed by the applicant/accused Mr. Manohar Rajaram Surve for seeking permission to travel abroad i.e U.S.A. from 10.11.2021 to 15.03.2022 to meet his daughter. It is averred in the application that he was granted permission to travel abroad in No.148/MA/2021 vide order dated 08.02.2021 for the same but he could not utilize the benefit of the said order due to pandemic of Covid - 19 and lockdown as his air tickets were cancelled. He has specifically stated that he will abide all the conditions imposed on him.

2. The Investigating Officer of G.B.C.B, CID, E.O.W, Mumbai has filed his say and objected for the relief sought by the applicant stating that charge-sheet has been filed against accused and if permission granted to travel abroad, he will abscond and the trial will be frustrated. Hence the application be rejected.

3. Heard. After perusing of the record, it seems that the applicant/accused was permitted to travel abroad earlier. The applicants/accused stated that he was granted permission to travel abroad in No.148/MA/2021 vide order dated 08.02.2021 but he could not utilize the benefit of the said order due to pandemic of Covid - 19 and lockdown and he deposited amount of Rs.100,000/- towards security for his traveling abroad as per order dated 08.02.2021. Now again he intends to travel abroad for the above mentioned period. He can be permitted to travel abroad as prayed. Accordingly, I pass following order:

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ORDER

- i. Application is allowed.
- ii. The applicant/Accused Mr. Manohar Rajaram Surve is permitted to travel abroad i.e. USA from 10.11.2021 to 15.03.2022.
- iii. He has already deposited amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lac only) as cash security for his traveling abroad, if he has withdrawn the earlier amount, he shall deposit the entire amount. Judicial Clerk to verify the amount.
- iv. The applicant/accused shall submit details of his itinerary to the court and also to EOW, Mumbai 24 hours before his departure.
- v. The applicant accused shall mark his presence before the court when he returned back to India.
- vi. He shall give the authenticated details of two of his relatives with address proof and contact numbers along with his own.
- vii. He shall remain present in this case as and when required. The accused shall not seek extension from abroad.
- viii. The defence Advocate shall not challenge his identity in the trial in his absence.
