(Sangita Vs. Mahadeo & Ors.)

This is an application filed by the plaintiff for grant of status-quo. It has been contended by the plaintiff that the matter has been fixed for filing of say on the temporary injunction application. However, the defendants No.4A and 4B are intentionally prolonging the matter. They failed to file their reply today. The suit properties is not yet partition still the defendants are carrying out their illegal construction on it. If they keep the construction going on, it will cause irreparable to the suit field and the plaintiff will have to suffer.

2. The present application has been replied by the concerned defendants No. 1 to 4. They submitted that they have filed their written statement and reply to the temporary injunction application on today. Therefore, the present application be rejected.

3. Perused the application and say along with the entire record. Today, the concerned defendants have filed their written statement along with their reply to the temporary injunction application. Therefore, the matter can be decided on merit by expediting it. In such circumstances, the present application is liable to be rejected. Hence, the order:

ORDER

1. The application (Exh.21) is hereby rejected.
2. Both the parties are directed to argue on the application for temporary injunction on next date without fail.
