Perused the record. It is fixed for evidence of the complainant before framing of charge. However, the complainant and his Ld. Advocate are absent when called out repeatedly. No effective steps have been taken by the complainant. On the other hand, the accused are regularly attending the matter. This is a matter of year 2023. However, there is no progress in it due to continuous absence of the complainant. It shows that he has lost his interest in the litigation.

Today also complainant and Ld. Advocate are absent when called out repeatedly. There is no progress in the matter since long and it is pending on daily board without any further progress. This is a private complaint case. There are repeated directions of Hon'ble Higher Court to dispose of old matters on top priority. Therefore, it be kept for dismissal order.
