

ORDER BELOW EXH.51 IN R. C. S. NO. 89 OF 2005.
(Bhanudas Yashwant Deshmukh and Another Vs. Baburao Maruti
Phadatare Deshmukh and Others.)

01. Perused the application submitted by the plaintiffs for service of summons on the defendant Nos. 7, 8 and 10 by newspaper publication.

02. Perused the record. Record shows that several times the plaintiffs have attempted to serve the summons on the defendant Nos. 7, 8 and 10.

03. Perused affidavit of the plaintiff No. 2. Satisfactory reasons are borne on record to believe that the defendant No. 7, 8 and 10 are deliberately avoiding service of summons by usual mode. Since the summons can not be served in the ordinary mode, issue proclamation to the defendant Nos. 7, 8 and 10 in daily local news paper "Daily Aikya".

04. Plaintiffs are directed to produce quotation about cost of publication and affidavit in support within 10 days, and deposit amount corresponding to the cost of publication as found in quotation.

05. Summon shall be returnable on 08.01.2026.

06. Plaintiffs shall file affidavit of compliance along with copy of publication.
