

**ORDER BELOW EXH.17 IN  
CRIMINAL BAIL APPLICATION NO: 186/2025**

The applicant-accused Vikram Vasant Erande has filed this application for interim anticipatory bail by contending that his mother is recently died and to attend the funeral and post funeral rituals, he may be granted temporary interim protection.

2. Today, the Court is open due to National Lok Adalat. Advocate Shri. R.H. Bhosale is present in the Court. He submitted that he is appearing for the informant and the informant is also present. So this Court heard the informant.

3. The Ld. Advocate Shri. A.A.Chikane appearing for the accused, submitted that his mother expired today and for attending funeral and post funeral rituals, he may be granted three days interim anticipatory bail.

4. The Ld. Advocate Shri. Bhosale opposed this submission by contending that the applicant-accused was absconding. Further, he has criminal antecedents. He has committed serious offence and his custodial interrogation is necessary. He further submitted that if the temporary anticipatory bail is granted to attend the funeral of his mother, then he be directed to surrender before the Investigating Officer.

5. On perusal of the death information issued by Municipal Corporation, Pune annexed with the application it appears that Maya Vasant Erande mother of applicant-accused died today and place of proposed funeral is crematory at Wai.

6. The material on record shows that today the mother of the

accused is expired. The accused has to attend the funeral of his mother. Considering the special and exceptional circumstances, this Court pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1. The application is partly allowed.
2. The Investigating Officer is ordered, not to take coercive action against the applicant-accused for three days i.e. till 12:00 midnight of 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.
3. Inform accordingly to the concerned Investigating Officer.
