By this application, accused has prayed for permission to obtain Passport.

2] It is submitted that, accused is permanent resident within the territorial jurisdiction of this Court. He intend to travel abroad. But because of pendency of this case, he cannot apply for Passport and therefore, he prayed for permission of this Court to obtain Passport. Hence, this application.

3] I.O. and Ld. APP resisted the application by filing say at Exh.12. According to them, accused is a News Reporter and having knowledge of law and therefore, he will take disadvantage of the opportunity given to him and he will be absconded and therefore, I.O and APP prayed to reject the application.

4] Perused the application and say. Heard both sides. Undisputedly, trial will take much time to conclude and meanwhile if accused travelled abroad, then no any harm or prejudice would be caused to the prosecution. Moreover, at this stage, he is not seeking any permission to travel out of the country. He is seeking permission of only getting passport and in my view, no reason to

reject his prayer. Accordingly, order.

ORDER

Application is allowed and accused Ajay Gorakh Sankpal is permitted to obtain Passport from the Passport Authority.
