

ORDER BELOW APPLICATION (EXH.18) IN
SESSIONS CASE NO. 68 OF 2023
CNR MHST19001221-2023
(State of Maharashtra Vs. Dilip Dnyandev Babar)

The applicant/accused No.9 (Dilip Dnyandev Babar) seeks permission for renewal of passport.

02] The accused is prosecuted for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148, 149, 326, 324, 332 and 353 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 135 of the Bombay Police Act.

03] The applicant/accused No.9 has filed the present application contending that he intends to go abroad for his tour purposes and will return to India. Validity of his passport is going to expire. Hence, he has prayed for permission for renewal of the passport.

04] The respondent/State by filing say (Exh.23) resisted the application.

05] The facts and circumstances of the matter prima facie speak that the applicant intends to go abroad for his tour purpose and will return to India.

06] The record and proceeding discloses that the charge is framed and the matter is fixed for hearing. The applicant has filed copies of his immovable properties situated in the State of Maharashtra. Considering his position as well as existence of his

immovable properties at village Udatare, Taluka Wai, District Satara there is also little scope of his absconding. In the circumstances, it would be just and proper to permit him to visit abroad for his tour.

10] In the circumstances, the applicant deserves to renew his passport. In the result, the application deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, I pass following order :

: ORDER :

- 01] The application (Exh.18) is allowed.
- 02] The Passport Authority is at liberty to renew passport of applicant-accused No.9 (Dilip Dnyandev Babar).
